

HOME MISSIONS

California - Big Springs

This new URC work is situated in a community where many retirees have settled. Rev. Nollie Malabuyo is presently serving in this mission.

California - Ontario

'Iglesia Reformada Unidad' is a church plant serving a community where over half of the population speaks Spanish. Rev. Taylor Kern leads the Hispanic congregation in active outreach.

Colorado - Colorado Springs

Rev. Tony Phelps is the church-planting pastor of Covenant URC. This church plant has a new members' class and is focusing on leadership training.

Illinois - Chicago Heights

Rev. Ruben Sernas is pastor of 'El Pacto de Gracia,' a Spanish-speaking church plant in the southern suburbs of Chicago. He leads this small congregation in worship and outreach.

Kentucky

Rev. Andrew Spriensma serves as a U.S. Army Chaplain and is currently stationed in the Middle East. He leads church services on Sundays and provides spiritual help and direction for the soldiers under his care.

Maryland - Cambridge

Rev. Steve Arrick is pastor at Redeemer Presbyterian Church. He is leading this growing group of core families through the process of organizing as a URCNA church.

Ohio - Cincinnati

Westside Reformed Church is pastored by Rev. Zac Wyse. This church plant has a stable core group and is actively reaching out in the community.

Ontario - Ajax

Rev. Brian Zegers is ministering in an area of Toronto that has a large Muslim population. He leads Bible studies and public forums on the Christian faith.

Ontario - Niagara Falls

Rev. Richard Bultje is the church-planting missionary at River of Life Ministry. Begun in 2013, this church plant meets in a converted storefront in this needy tourist and casino town.

Ontario - Scarborough

Rev. Mitchell Persaud pastors New Horizon Church, an active church-plant among the immigrant population on the east side of Toronto.

Ontario - Toronto

The Hope Center reaches out to the Sikh and Hindu community in Canada's largest city. Rev. Tony Zekveld preaches and evangelizes here in both English and Punjabi. The Hope Academy is a small mission school that has also been established.

Ontario - St. Catharines

Rev. Thabet Megaly is missionary to the Muslim population in the Niagara area using local fellowship programs, television, and radio.

Ontario - Waterdown

Living Hope Reformed Church is centrally located in one of the most populated urban areas of Canada. Ten families form a core group that is actively reaching out in their community. Rev. Daniel and Brooke Ventura are presently serving here.

New Jersey - Jersey City

Rev. Sam Perez pastors Grace Reformed Church in a location just across the river from New York City. This church plant has families from a variety of backgrounds.

Saskatchewan - Regina

Rev. Brian Cochran does the work of an evangelist and pastor at Redeemer Reformation Church in this growing mid-western Canadian city.

Divine Hope Reformed Bible Seminary

DHRBS is a dedicated prison seminary with campuses in Illinois and Indiana. The seminary trains qualified students to deliver sermons and evangelize imprisoned men. The professors are: Rev. Nathan Brummel (Systematic Theology), Rev. Ken Anema (Old Testament), and Rev. Paul Ipema (Ministerial Studies).

FOREIGN MISSIONS

Costa Rica

Costa Rica is a Spanish-speaking country with approximately 4.5 million people. Rev. Bill Green is pastor and missionary in 'Pacto de Gracia' Church in Guadalupe. He also labours in Tepeyac Christian School and CLIR, (Latin American Fellowship of Reformed Churches), which prints and distributes Reformed literature in the Spanish language.

Ecuador

This Spanish speaking country in South America is a contrast of isolated jungle and modern city. The capital city of Quito has a population of 1.8 million people. Rev. Pablo Landazuri is the pastor of 'Iglesia Reformada Luz de Vida,' a church in the heart of this needy city.

Mexico

Rev. Matthew VanDyken is pastor and missionary in 'Iglesia Vida Eterna' in Tepic, Nayarit in central Mexico. With a population of 125 million people, Mexico's need for faithful gospel witness is overwhelming. Many of those attending the church in Tepic are new converts, so much time is dedicated to one-on-one discipleship. This church has an ordained national elder and deacon.

Honduras

In recent years the radical charismatic movement has devastated the spiritual landscape and affected the majority of evangelical churches. In this volatile environment, Rev. Ernie Langedoen has brought the Word for many years in "Iglesia Reformada de Comayagua", and assisted in small groups in Tegucigalpa, Choluteca, and San Pedro Sula.

Italy

The 'Chiesa Riformata Evangelica Filadelfia' is located in Milan, a modern university city in northern Italy. Rev. Andrea Ferrari has laboured there for over fifteen years. Rev. Michael Brown will be joining the church there as pastor, while Rev. Ferrari moves to a newly established church plant in Perugia, five hours to the south. They will continue to reach out to other like-minded congregations both in Italy and other European countries.

India

India's population of 1.2 billion people is 84% practising Hindu and 12% Islamic. The need for the gospel cannot be overstated. Rev. Steve Poelman laboured in both southern and northern India for many years, most recently in the Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Dehradun. Rev. Poelman and his family are currently in the United States. They are seeking the Lord's will for their family and ministry.

Romania

This eastern European country was freed from 42 years Communist rule in 1989. Culturally rich and beautiful, the nation now lies under a thick blanket of atheism and political upheaval. Rev. Mihai Corcea has been called to minister in a newly formed church plant called the "Evangelical Reformed Church of Bucharest."

MINTS International Seminary

MINTS provides distance education on an interdenominational level, and teaches from a Biblical and Reformed perspective. Courses are written in 11 languages and are available free of charge through a variety of on-line programs. Rev. Neal Hegeman, Rev. Eric Pennings and Rev. Allen Vander Pol are all professors in MINTS.
